

## **NEED A RIDE TO SACRAMENTO?**

The Commuter Express provides peak hour service to downtown Sacramento on our special commuter buses with nine morning and ten afternoon schedules each weekday.

The Midday Express offers three weekday schedules to downtown Sacramento during non-commute hours including a noon-hour schedule.

## TRANSFERRING IN SACRAMENTO?

Yuba-Sutter Transit offers convenient connections to light rail and major regional bus routes in downtown Sacramento. Use Google Transit or call 511 toll free for Sacramento area route and schedule information.

# **BIKE RACKS AND LOCKERS**

Bike racks are available on all buses on a first-come, first-served basis. Bicycle storage lockers are available for rent at most major local commuter stops. Call (530) 634-6880 for a free bike guide or for locker rental information.

# **ENHANCED REVERSE SERVICE**

Try our enhanced reverse service from Sacramento in the morning and back in the afternoon. Now offering limited service directly to and from the Caltrans building in Marysville. All morning downtown arrival times are approximate, so arrive at least 10 minutes early to avoid missing the bus. Call (530) 742-2877 or 511 toll free for more information.

# WHAT ABOUT EMERGENCIES?

You have a "Guaranteed Ride Home" if you ride the bus at least three days a week and your employer is enrolled in the program. This program provides free access to a rental car for 24 hours for qualifying emergencies. Ask your employer if this service is provided with their Transportation Management Association (TMA) membership.

Valid senior/disabled/youth photo I.D. cards issued by another transit agency will be honored for up to 21 days. Medicare card and DMV placard holders may be required to provide photo I.D.

# **CONNECT CARD**

The Connect Card is the easy way to pay transit fares. It is a plastic, reloadable smart card with an embedded computer chip that can store

cash value and/or monthly passes for any regular or discounted fares. It's accepted by Yuba-Sutter Transit, Sacramento Regional Transit and seven other transit providers in the greater Sacramento area.

Visit **ConnectTransitCard.com** to get started. Once you initially order and load your full fare\* Connect Card online, you'll receive it in the mail in 3 - 5 days. Just tap it on the Connect Card reader when you board any Yuba-Sutter Transit bus and reload as needed.

\*Discount fare passengers must visit the Yuba-Sutter Transit office

for their first Connect Card which will also become their new photo I.D. card for discount fare eligibility purposes.

# **CONNECT CARD OUTLETS**

All monthly passes and \$10 ticket sheets are available at the main Yuba and Sutter County Libraries as well as the Yuba College Bookstore. Passes, ticket sheets and single ride tickets are available at the Yuba-Sutter Transit Administrative Office or by mail. Call (530) 634-6880 for more information.

# **EMPLOYEE FARE SUBSIDIES**

Many public and private Sacramento employers provide fare subsidies to their employees who commute by public transit. For example, the State of California subsidizes 75 percent of the cost up to \$65 a month — some provide even more. Check with your employer to see if a subsidy is available to you!
