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JULY 1ST FARE INCREASES & SACRAMENTO SCHEDULE CHANGES REFLECTED IN NEW SERVICE BROCHURES

Our passenger information materials have been updated and are now available to reflect systemwide fare increases along with additions, deletions, and modifications to the Sacramento schedules that all became effective on Monday, July 1st. The new Ride Guide and service brochures are now available on all buses as well as online at www.yubasuttertransit.com.

The basic cash fare on the local fixed route service is now \$1.50 per trip while the discount cash fare for eligible seniors, youth and persons with disabilities is \$0.75 per trip. The daily cap rate on the local fixed route service, which is available only with a Connect Card, is just \$3.00 and \$1.50 respectively so you can ride fare free for the rest of the day after just two taps. The cost of our basic and discount local fixed route passes are still just \$30 and \$5 per month respectively.

Before 6:00 p.m., the Dial-A-Ride fare is now \$3.00 per trip for all eligible passengers. After 6:00 p.m., the basic fare for the weekday evening Dial-A-Ride service is now \$4.00 per trip while the discount fare is \$2.00 per trip. Monthly passes are not accepted and the daily cap does not apply to the Dial-A-Ride service.

The Sacramento Commuter pass is now \$135 a month while the basic cash fare is now \$4.50 per trip. The discount cash fare that is available only on Sacramento Midday schedules is now \$2.25 per trip. If you receive your Sacramento monthly pass through the Connect Card auto-load feature, you will need to reset your account for the new price or the auto-load feature will not otherwise load your July pass.

The new Sacramento service brochure includes the new morning and afternoon Highway 70 schedules; the elimination of one afternoon Highway 99 schedule; other adjustments to better reflect current travel times between Marysville/Yuba City and Sacramento as well as within the downtown area; and, express reverse commute service and an earlier afternoon departure to and from the Caltrans District 3 office in Marysville.

The basic cash fare on our three rural routes (Foothills, Live Oak and Wheatland) is now \$3.00 per trip while the discount cash fare is now \$1.50 per trip. The daily cap does not apply to the rural routes, but all of our monthly passes are now accepted on any rural route.

For customer convenience due to the new cash fares, a new \$15 sheet of twenty \$0.75 tickets is now available. The \$10 sheet of twenty \$0.50 tickets continues to be sold and accepted at face value for use on all services. Ticket sheets are available only in person or by mail from the Yuba-Sutter Transit Administrative Office in Marysville.

Marysville Peach Festival



FESTIVAL TO CLOSE D STREET ON JULY 19TH & 20TH

The annual Peach Festival in Historic Downtown Marysville will be held on Friday, July 19th and Saturday, July 20th this year. This free event will be held from 4:00 to 10:00 p.m. on Friday and from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Saturday. As a result, D Street will be closed to vehicle traffic from 1st through 7th Streets on both days. As a result, Yuba-Sutter Transit will suspend service to two downtown bus stops at D and 2nd and F & 2nd Streets for all of both festival days.

Westbound Route 1 buses coming off the E Street Bridge from Linda will turn left at Third Street. Eastbound Route 1 buses on Third Street will turn right on F Street and use the Highway 70 on-ramp to Linda and Yuba College.

Route 4A buses traveling south on B Street will turn right on First Street before using the Highway 70 on-ramp to Linda and the Peach Tree Clinic. Route 4B buses traveling east on Third Street will turn right on F Street before using the Highway 70 on-ramp to Linda and the Peach Tree Clinic. Route 4A buses traveling north on the E Street Bridge returning to Marysville from Linda will turn left on Third Street and continue west on the existing route to H Street. Route 4B buses traveling in the same direction will turn left on Third Street and left on F Street before rejoining the existing route on First Street.

As a result, the nearest available bus stops to downtown Marysville on these two days will be at Rideout Hospital on Third Street in both directions for Routes 1 and 4 and at B & Third Streets for Routes 4A and 4B. NEW DIAL-A-RIDE BUSES WILL SOON BE IN SERVICE

Ten new Dial-A-Ride buses have arrived and are now being prepped for service. These buses will soon replace ten 2009 model buses that long ago passed their useful life. The new buses are currently being inspected for acceptance, decals will soon be applied and our maintenance crew will move the Connect Card and DoubleMap systems from the old buses as soon as the new buses are ready to go into service.

Like the buses being replaced, the new buses will primarily be used for our Dial-A-Ride and rural route services, but they will also back up the local fixed route system when necessary. Nearly identical to the six small buses that were purchased in 2014, the new buses are the first gasoline powered buses in Yuba-Sutter Transit's fleet in over 15 years as diesel is no longer an option on this class of vehicle. The new buses will also feature a new style of two-position bike racks.

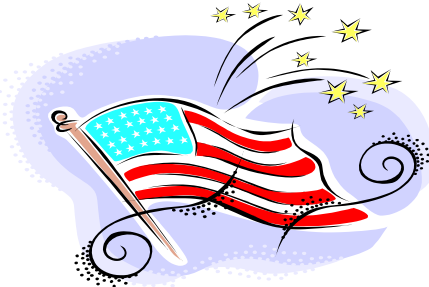

LATEST STOP ENHANCEMENT PROJECT NEARLY COMPLETE

Yuba-Sutter Transit is just wrapping up a significant bus stop enhancement project that includes the installation of extra-large solar lighted bus stop shelters at three major transit centers; the relocation of five smaller shelters and another five bus stop benches to other bus stops; and, the installation of 48 small two-person bus stop seats throughout the local fixed route system.

In particular, the new bus stop seats are expected to make a big difference for our passengers because their design allows for their installation where traditional bus stop benches and shelters are just not possible due to narrow sidewalks or no sidewalk at all.
